Criteria 1 curriculum planning

- Enhance stakeholder's participation in curriculum and syllabus development (ideas, feedback)
- Upgrade the curriculum as per the outcome based framework
- Integrate SDGs into the curriculum
- Map the curriculum for the possibility of credit transfers (SWAYAM)
- Encourage faculty to develop e-content, OER, and online courses
- Offer more choices in electives/ optional courses
- Provide more value added courses
- Networking with a variety of organizations for promoting enriched teaching learning experiences and facilitating choice-based courses.

Criteria 2 Teaching-learning and evaluation

- Conduct need assessment for improving quality of programs offered
- Redesign sessional assessments (more self-directed)
- Plan for varied Industry (rural, urban) focused internship
- Encourage self-directed & self-regulated learning
- Encourage and train faculty members for intensive use of ICT for teaching-learning and assessment
- Encourage blended learning for various courses to reach out to learners in distant places
- Use LMS for enhancing learning
- Use innovative pedagogies for effective teaching-learning

Criteria 3 Research & outreach activities

- Enhance the research capacity of the B.Ed. students
- Expand the research facilities in the college library
- Encourage the faculty members to take up research projects/ collaborative research projects and attract more funding for research
- Encourage more faculty members to take up research guideships (Ph. D)
- Conducting a variety of research activities (paper readings, study circles etc.)
- Promote participation of faculty in conducting research and publication in indexed research journals
- Provide financial assistance to researchers/faculty members for conducting research.
- Undertake appraisals of institutional functioning
- Increase student involvement in paper presentation/publications
- Participate in national priority programs (Swachh Bharat, AIDs awareness, gender sensitivity, yoga, digital India, National water mission)
- Take up community work/ outreach programs addressing the SDGs
- Subscribe to more e-journals and add more e-resources
- Start digital journal of the institution

- Explore the possibility of remote access to other libraries through MOUs
- Upgrade Smart classrooms
- Increase student computer ratio

- Strengthen digital repository in the college library and provide remote access to all the e-resources of the library
- Develop infrastructure for green campus

- expand book bank to non-text, relevant & inspiring books
- Provide placement support and training for competitive exams
- Create disable friendly environment by updating infrastructure and providing academic assistance
