Plan of Action (POA)

Internal & External Meetings

The IQAC facilitated two external meetings fostering collaboration and idea exchange with external stakeholders to enhance the overall quality of education. Internal meetings involving all faculty members were also conducted to discuss significant ideas and issues.

Staff empowering Workshops/sessions

IQAC organized a session on "Outcome Based Education" for the College faculty on 21st Oct 2023. The resource person was Dr. Giselle D'souza, I/C principal of St. Teresa institute of Education. She discussed the calculation for OBE feasible for College of education.

IQAC organized an empowering workshop on 30th December 2023 for non-teaching staff across educational institutions under Sadhana Education Society and nearby areas. The workshop, guided by Core Performing Space, was designed for the non-teaching staff of the various colleges. Using various theatre techniques, the resource people highlighted personal and professional issues and guided the participants on how changing their communication styles could improve their interpersonal relationships in both personal and professional settings.

Feedbacks
