Community Engagement Activities Report
(2024-25)

KKCE believes in progressive humane and progressive teacher professionals who are sensitive towards the needs of the community. To develop this understanding, College provides ample opportunities for students to engage in community service and participate in service-oriented learning and reflections. For the academic year 2024-25, the Community Engagement Department has organized several activities to help students learn through service. These activities include Community work for a duration of 20 hours spread across 5 days and fund raising by diya Sell in association with Akshay Shakti foundation and STEM workshop in association with Indian Development Foundation (IDF) as part of Extension Work.

Community Work for the academic year 2024-25 was organized in two separate sessions. One for F.Y. B.Ed. Student from 20.01.25 to 24.01.25 and Second for S.Y. B.Ed. from 03.03.25 to 07.03.25. During the community work a total of 94 students (47 from FY and 47 from SY) participated in the community work and visited special education centers and underprivileged schools situated at various locations. The name of these Institutes includes, St. Catherine school, Baljeevan Trust, and Aakanansha Foundation managed BMC public schools at Andheri and Dadar, Educo managed BMC public school at Dadar and Parel. During these visits, students were expected to complete their mandatory 20 hours of community service under the supervision of the centre in charge. The college has assigned faculties in charge of each group visiting the respective centre to ensure meaningful and productive work during community work. At community centres, student teachers assisted the class teacher in handling the class, conducted sessions with the students, helped the institute to organize various programs and activities, assisted students through remedial teaching, etc.

Post the community work the students reflected positively towards the Community work and expressed that they had an enriching experience which they will cherish for a long time.

Another meaningful activity organized by the college under community engagement was fundraising for underprivileged by selling diya prepared by them and supported by Akshay Shakti foundation. Student sold hand made diya to their peers and teachers and raised fund of Rs. 5400/- which was donated to Akshay shakti foundation.

Apart from these, as part of extension activities FY B.Ed. students also participated in a STEM Workshop organized by Indian Development foundation on 20.12.2024.
