The Student Council has been a driving force behind a series of engaging events throughout the academic year, creating opportunities for students to showcase their talents, celebrate cultural values, and build community spirit. Here is a brief account of each event organized during AY 2024-25:

On 20th July – Guru Purnima Celebration was the first event the council initiated the year with. Students honored the guiding principles of knowledge and mentorship through an inspiring Guru Purnima celebration, where students shared creative presentations on the socio-cultural significance of their teachers. A heartfelt farewell was organized on 31st July to honor the contributions of a respected senior faculty member, marking their retirement with a touching tribute and memorable moments. In month of August, The patriotic spirit was ignited during the Independence Day celebration, as students and staff came together in a series of cultural performances and flag-hoisting ceremonies. 5th September was the day dedicated to teachers as students celebrated Teachers' Day. In recognition of the teachers' enduring commitment, the Council coordinated a memorable Teachers' Day event, featuring interactive presentations and messages of gratitude.

Student council supported in organizing Hindi Diwas Celebration, by the Hindi/Language Club. This event celebrated the beauty and richness of the Hindi language through literary recitations and cultural performances. On 10th October during Saraswati Pooja & Navratri Celebration the festive spirit was evident among students as they observed Saraswati Pooja and kicked off Navratri with colorful rituals, traditional dances, and cultural expressions.

As the new batch started, on 10th October under STIP - A special student and college Introduction session was held to introduce the new batch of students. This helped bridge connections between educators, students and college. To empower new student leaders, an orientation session was conducted on 14th November, outlining responsibilities and encouraging active participation in council initiatives. On 15th October, FY B.Ed. Ice Breaker session was organized to help students foster new friendships and ease their transition into college life. Second Year Students welcomed their FY peers on 21st October ensuring a seamless integration through engaging activities and experience sharing.

The Council celebrated Navratri and Diwali with vibrant cultural competitions that highlighted students' diverse talents in music, dance, and art against the backdrop of traditional festivities on 25th October.

This was followed by Student Council Election on 7th December after a week. The
